Hello Everyone.

As I write this note there is a definite winter feel in the air! I am looking forward to seeing the white stuff fall from the air. I hope you are all getting geared up for the great season that is forthcoming.

This equipment flyer will help get the brains into ski mode. Mammoth Ski Team is proud to be associated with all of our Mammoth Retailers and we highly recommend all products carried by them. I would like to give our sincere thanks to all of our Retailers, who always give our Team 100% support. I would also like to thank all of our Manufacturers and associated Representatives. The key points that you will need to share with our Retailers and Reps are: Athlete's ability and intensity, Age, Weight, and Height (in centimeters to the top of head and to nose level). This will make it easier to recommend boots that will flex easily, as well as appropriate type of skis. A general rule of thumb is that J5's and younger will need only one pair of skis, these should have a slalom type sidecut. J4's and older (depending on commitment level) will generally look at event specific skis i.e. 1 pair for Slalom and 1 pair of Giant Slalom. Safety equipment is a key component for all. We recommend spine protectors for all Freeride and J3 and older athletes.

As always, there will be Mammoth Ski Team staff on hand to assist with choices in conjunction with retail staff.

The physical testing has been an outstanding success over the past couple of years. Please RSVP to the office for all J5 and older athletes who will be participating. This information is sent to USSA, who have now collated enough data to be able to deliver specific gender and age group rankings. This is invaluable information for athlete goal setting.

If within two years of the date of purchase of a pair of ski boots, the buyer outgrows the boots (in size), they can return the boots for a 50% credit toward the purchase of the new pair of boots.

In addition, any child still in their growing years can purchase a Surefoot orthotic along with ski boots and if they outgrow the Surefoot orthotic they can get a new one with the purchase of a ski boot at no charge.

Mammoth Surefoot will be stocking Nordica, Lange and Tecnica junior/adult race boots. We will also be carrying a selection of junior free ride boots. Once again, we will have a full selection of POC helmets, goggles and protective gear for racers and free riders. Look forward to seeing everyone soon.

***J 1-3 Athletes and Parents.**

Our Fall physical assessment is coming up: October 24-25th to be exact!!!

This assessment is aimed at J1-3 and Free ride athletes, mandatory if you intend on participating in any Alpine Western Region Project during the next year. The testing will be available to J4-5 athletes who are interested. The assessment is designed to help tracking of the older athletes who have been training specifically over the summer, so that we can gauge where they are in preparation for the competition season. The weekend will comprise of testing both Saturday and Sunday looking at body composition, aerobic and anaerobic capacity, flexibility, explosiveness and core strength.

The tentative schedule will be:

Saturday 24th 8:30am- 12 noon.

Sunday 25th 8:30am- 12 noon.

****Both days may finish earlier depending on numbers. I will email with any changes the week prior.**

We will be running the assessment at Snowcreek Athletic Club- everyone will need to sign in each day. If you are not a member there will be a daily fee and a parent will need to sign a release (when you RSVP if you let Pam or I know you are not a member I will email the liability to you).

Please wear appropriate athletic clothing- running shoes, shorts, t-shirt. Bring something warm to wear after the test, and make sure you have a water bottle.

Please RSVP to the Ski Team Office by October 16th so that we can plan for the test. If you are only able to make one day please advise with your RSVP.

On Sunday there will be a breakfast for athletes and families of Mammoth Ski Team hosted by the MSSEF at the club, athletes can attend after they complete testing. The breakfast will be free for MSSEF members, \$5 for non-members. We need RSVPs for the breakfast as well.
