

J3 Travel Policy 2008/09

We will try to accommodate every one who needs a spot on the travel team, sometimes our numbers are limited due to the vans we take. If the situation occurs where we have more names than places, it will be decided on attendance. (weekend attendance for everyone).

Other policies for travel are:

No video game players of any type (xbox, playstation, gameboy, etc.)

Seatbelts must be worn at all times in the team vans.

No open drink containers or hot food on the van.

The Travel Team is a privilege which can be taken away. If you do not follow the team rules and act accordingly you will not be invited back with the team.

Below is the MMST travel policy.

TRAVEL CANCELLATION POLICY

In the event an athlete opts not to attend an event that he or she has already signed up for, the following policy will apply:

Full refund / No Charge

This applies when the cancellation is made before any travel or accommodation arrangements have been secured.

Accommodation Charge

If the cancellation is made after accommodation arrangements have been secured but more than one week prior to the event, the athlete will be responsible for the full athlete accommodation charge.

Full Expense Charge

If the cancellation is made with 2-7 days notice, the athlete will be responsible for all athlete trip expenses excluding lifts and entry fees. If prepaid, lift and entry expenses will be refunded.

No Refund

This applies when the cancellation is made the day before departure or later, or when no notice is received that the athlete will not attend.
