

FIND YOUR SKI BOOT SIZE

Ski boots feel and perform best when they fit properly. To help you have more fun on the slopes, use this Mondopoint size chart to check ski boot sizes for the whole family prior to renting. Mondopoint sizing is the length of your foot in centimeters.

STEP 1

Print and check scale with a credit card. Card should fit inside the lines without any margin of error to ensure proper sizing.

STEP 2

Fold up the lower right corner along the blue line. Place this paper on the floor against the wall or a hard surface. Use tape to secure to the floor.

STEP 3

Stand on the paper with your bare foot so that your heel barely touches the wall. Align your foot to the size chart with weight down on your foot; measure both feet in this way. The line closest to the tip of your longest toe but does not touch is your size.

MY SIZE

No printer? No problem.

While measuring is helpful, you can always convert from your standard shoe size as well. Use this chart below to compare your shoe size to the cm length (Mondopoint).

Sizes are measured in centimeters from blue line.

Place a credit card here to ensure the scale is correct. Printers like to shrink things, so be sure to print actual size. Do not shrink, scale, or fit to printable area.

Fold along line and align the edge against a wall. This line should be perpendicular to the wall.
