Highlight What's New in Mammoth Lakes This Summer

Mammoth Lakes, Calif. (May 7, 2024) — Mammoth Lakes is gearing up for another beautiful summer season. As the spring runoff begins in earnest and the winter snow melts away, visitors can expect surging waterfalls, brimming lakes, and a vibrant landscape of wildflowers on full display.

Summer air service into the Eastern Sierra returns with options from Southern California and Northern California. Once you're on the ground, there are an infinite number of activities to enjoy, hidden gems to explore, live music and events, and so much more.

Events

- Mammoth Trailfest 50K, 26K, DRAGON'S BACK ASCENT & KID'S 1K Enjoy a
 weekend of community focused trail running. From world-class trail races and community
 focused events, to free live entertainment, storytelling, and great local food, Mammoth
 Trailfest is a multi-day experience designed to increase access to trail and ultrarunning

- The OCR World Championships (OCRWC), the pinnacle event of championship obstacle course racing, returns to Mammoth Lakes October 4-6. Known for pushing boundaries and uniting obstacle course enthusiasts from around the globe, 2024 OCRWC promises an unforgettable experience for participants and spectators alike. The event will feature five challenging distances designed to test competitors' strength, endurance, and agility, reaffirming its status as the premier obstacle course racing championship. For those who are building their skills or are interested in trying obstacle course racing for the first time, the weekend will also feature a 5K Charity Open featuring 15+ obstacles in an untimed format. No experience required.

Flights

 Advanced Airlines has announced its summer schedule for direct flights from Mammoth Yosemite Airport in Mammoth Lakes (MMH) to Carlsbad (CLD) and Hawthrone (HHR).
 Service will run Fridays and Sundays from June 28th through September 2 (Labor Day).
 There will be additional flights from CLD & HHR on Wednesday July 3rd for the holiday.

- Harmony Brazilian Steakhouse Another newcomer to the Mammoth Lakes restaurant scene, Harmony's menu is inspired by the rich culinary traditions of Brazil. Reds Meadow

- Reds Meadow Road is being reconstructed to improve public access and traffic safety
 for all who visit the area. Reds Meadow Road will be open for the season starting June
 7th, with the road open Friday morning to Sunday evening each week. Reds Meadow
 Road will be closed 24 hours per day for construction work Sunday at 11:00 PM through
 Friday at 9:00 AM. More information about the project is available here.

New at Mammoth Mountain

- Woolly's Adventure Summit A hub of activity and exploration, progression of Woolly's
 Adventure Summit will include re-opening of the Mountain Coaster, and the addition of
 summer tubing lanes for Summer 2024. Woolly's Mountain Coaster provides a thrilling
 ride down exciting curves, spiral twists and roller jumps through the forest as they
 descend 3,550 ft of downhill track back down to the base.
- Mammoth Mountain's world-renowned <u>bike park</u> is back in a big way with a full season of
 operations on tap for this summer. After historic snowfall in 2023 left many trails buried
 under snow late into the year, the team has been working hard to rebuild, refine, and
 improve fun and flow across the mountain.
- Located on the rugged cliffs below the Caldera Overlook adjacent to McCoy Station, the Mammoth Mountain <u>Via Ferrata</u> is also back for Summer 2024. Via Ferrata, which means "iron path" in Italian, is a network of climbing routes using steel cables, iron rungs and suspended bridges fixed to the rock that climbers are attached to for safety. With six





different routes that progress in difficulty, the experience ends with the elation of having climbed to one of the best viewpoints in all of the Sierra. Via Ferrata is the perfect alpine activity for families and individuals. No previous climbing experience required.

Stewardship

- Mammoth Lakes Tourism (MLT) is proud to continue its partnership with <u>Clean Up The Lake</u> (CUTL), and committing to cleaning up the region's lakes. CUTL will work alongside MLT to engage with visitors and the local community to increase education and further volunteer efforts towards remediating the issues at hand. Removal of submerged litter, documenting any and all aquatic invasive species threatening the lakes, working to protect animal species both above and below the surface- and prevention of future pollution are key goals of the partnership. <u>Every dollar raised over the 4-year partnership</u> (up to \$100,000) will be matched by MLT to support ongoing stewardship. This summer, Lake Mary will be a focus of the partnership. Expect to see divers and cleanup support teams in and around Lake Mary from July 8 through July 19.
- For the fourth year, Mammoth Lakes Tourism is partnering with Mammoth Mountain,
 Mammoth Waste Disposal, the Mammoth Lakes Trail System, Mammoth Lakes
 Recreation, and the Town of Mammoth Lakes for <u>Trashy Thursday</u> every Thursday from
 5-6 pm. Join MLT to clean up the community with a chance to win a \$50 gift card from
 Mammoth Lakes Tourism. Trash pickers, bags and gloves provided. Locations rotate
 weekly, so make sure you consult the schedule for each week's location.
