

## SCENIC GONDOLA RIDES

Take an aerial ride up to the summit to enjoy 360° views of the surrounding peaks and alpine lakes.

Take in the panoramic views of the Sierra and White Mountains, Minarets, Mono Lake, Yosemite peaks, and beyond at 11,053 ft. At the top, snap a selfie at the summit sign and enjoy lunch at the Eleven53 Café.

Load the Panorama Gondola in the building across from the Main Lodge west entrance. Check the *Lift & Trail Status* beforehand to check for weather holds on the gondola.

UP TO 2 KIDS (12 AND UNDER) RIDE FREE WITH EACH PAYING ADULT.

### ELEVEN53 INTERPRETIVE CENTER

Learn about the Eastern Sierra with fun interactive exhibits for all ages and a full-time docent to answer your questions and teach you even more. Unearth the volcanic history, geology, geography, weather patterns, cultural heritage and natural history of the surrounding regions. Admission is free with a Scenic Gondola Ride ticket, lift ticket, or Ikon Pass.

Kids and kids at heart will love zooming through the trees on the mountain coaster, in a high-speed snow tube, and on the all-new zip line. Even the littlest ones can join all the fun in the snow play area.

### MOUNTAIN COASTER

Hang on tight for this exhilarating journey on Mammoth's year-round Mountain Coaster. Speed down the mountain terrain and weave through the trees on a smooth, gliding toboggan while taking in the views and letting out a scream (or three).

### NEW! ZIP LINE

Fly without wings as you soar high in the air on Mammoth's new dual zip line. With the wind in your face and the ground rushing by below, this high-flying ride delivers quick thrills and big smiles for adventurers of all ages. **Weather permitting.**

### TUBE PARK

Zoom down 512 feet of snow-covered fun, then ride the conveyor lift to the top for another go. With mountain views and plenty of giggles, it's a must-do for the whole family. Walk-ups for sessions are based on availability.

### SNOW PLAY AREA

Perfect for mini adventurers who aren't ready to ride the mountain coaster or the tube park. Guests get all-day access to the snow play area with your tube park ticket.

### SOARING PINES MOUNTAIN CAFÉ

Nestled at the base of Woolly's Adventure Summit, Soaring Pines Mountain Café offers a warm and welcoming retreat for families. Gather around the hearth and savor rustic-inspired dishes, fresh food, and beverages crafted with care.
